## **Scope Description:**

The State of Maryland, through the Department of General Services ("DGS"), seeks to execute a participating addendum ("Participating Addendum") with Carahsoft Technology Corporation ("Carahsoft") under the National Association of State Procurement Officials ("NASPO Contract"). NASPO strives to make the governmental procurement process more efficient by establishing competitively priced contracts. This NASPO Contract is available to State agencies nationwide, institutions of higher education, cities and counties. It has been awarded by a public competitive procurement process that is compliant with Maryland State statues.

Under the Participating Addendum, Carahsoft would provide the Department of Information Technology with ongoing expert tier 3 support for the State's Google platform as follows:

Enhance the Google platform configuration with regards to email, mobile devices, Google Admin Console, and security; and

## **Basis for Selection:**

The use of this procurement method will reduce the time-period between need determination and delivery of the solution; will ensure expeditious transparency to the citizens of Maryland and reduce the administrative burden on DGS. In accordance with COMAR 21.05.09.04, it is determined that this Participating Addendum will provide cost benefits to the State, will promote administration efficiencies and promote intergovernmental cooperation. The Participation Addendum is in the best interest of the State and is not intended to evade the purpose of Division II of the State Finance Procurement Article.
