Overview

This Quick Reference Guide (QRG) is intended for Buyers and State employees. There are two ways to log in to the eMaryland Marketplace Advantage (eMMA) system. These instructions show users both methods for logging in to eMMA.

Log in with My Apps Dashboard

1. Navigate to login.md.gov and follow the prompts to enter your credentials and verify your account through a selected 2-factor authentication method.


