Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Procurement Officer Determination

COMAR 21.05.09.04

Per COMAR 21.05.09.02, as a Primary Procurement Unit, the DGS Office of State Procurement (OSP) may initially sponsor or participate in, renew, modify, or administer an Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Agreement (ICPA) on its own behalf or on behalf of another agency when a determination is made under SFP §13-110 and COMAR 21.05.09.04.

Based upon the analysis and market research conducted as identified in the attached Procurement Officer's Determination from The Comptroller's Office for OMNIA Partners ICPA - ADP Contract, the use of this ICPA will be used for electronic tax deposits, remittance and tax filings, quarterly reporting – Federal 941, State, and Unemployment Returns, complete amended returns, year-end processing and annual reconciliations, and risk mitigation methods. This will reduce the time period between need determination and delivery of unemployment wage reporting solutions. I have conducted an independent analysis and determined that it is in the best interest of the State to participate in this intergovernmental cooperative purchasing agreement, that doing so will provide cost benefits to the State, promote administrative efficiencies, or promote intergovernmental cooperation, and is not intended as a means to evade the purposes set forth under COMAR 21.01.03.

Scope Description:

The State of Maryland, through the Department of General Services ("DGS"), seeks to execute a participating addendum ("Participating Addendum") with ADP, Inc ("ADP") under the Region 4 ESC/OMNIA Partners, Public Sector, Human Capital Management and Managed Business Solutions, Contract # R200701 ("OMNIA Contract"). OMNIA strives to make the governmental procurement process more efficient by establishing competitively priced contracts. The OMNIA Contract is available to State agencies nationwide, institutions of higher education, cities and counties. It has been awarded by a public competitive procurement process that is compliant with Maryland State statues. Under the Participating Addendum, ADP would provide the Comptroller of Maryland (COM) with ADP's traditional product to handle all tax deposits, withholding reporting, and unemployment reporting. ADP will provide the following: electronic tax deposits, remittance and tax filings, quarterly reporting – Federal 941, State, and Unemployment Returns, complete amended returns, year-end processing and annual reconciliations, risk mitigation – 100% liability for errors and omissions, dedicated tax account manager, and a tailored service level agreement to meet the Comptroller's specific needs.

Basis for Selection:

ADP was selected as they are the # 1 ranked vendor on the OMNIA contract for Human Capital Management Systems and Managed Business Solutions software. ADP demonstrated the ability to provide the products and services outlined in the solicitation while offering competitive pricing to eligible using entities. The OMNIA Partners award to ADP was the result of a competitive process, conducted by the State of Texas, that selected ADP as the top provider of Human Capital Management Systems and Managed Business Solutions software products to eligible using entities. The OMNIA Partners Bid Tab Summary ranked ADP #1 of 11 proposals submitted in the following areas: Products/Pricing, Performance Capability, Qualification and Experience & Value Add.

ADP, Inc. was selected as #1 of three contractors on the OMNIA Partners contract, Human Capital Management Systems and Managed Business Solutions; RFP # 20-07. The rankings were:

- 1. ADP
- 2. Hire Thinking Inc. dba Advantage xPO
- 3. Carahsoft Technology Corporation

The use of this procurement method will reduce the time-period between need determination and delivery of unemployment wage reporting solution; will ensure expeditious transparency to the Human Capital Management Systems and Managed Business Solutions; RFP # 20-07 citizens of Maryland and reduce the administrative burden on the Comptroller. In accordance with COMAR 21.05.09.04, it is determined that this Participating Addendum will provide cost benefits to the State, will promote administration efficiencies and promote intergovernmental cooperation.

Based upon market research the Procurement Officer has determined that the ICPA/Omnia pricing remains competitive. A line item review of COM's ADP financial proposal based on the ICPA/Omnia contract agreement with two other ADP proposals under that same ICPA/Omnia showed the COM's price was significantly cheaper. For example, ADP cost per employee on COM's proposal is \$0.06 per month. two other quotes were \$0.10 and \$0.19 per employee. That is \$684,000 for three years (\$0.19) compared to COM's price of \$216,000. A savings of \$468,000 on that line item alone. Other ADP Tax Services in the COM's ADP financial proposal showed a similar savings.

If unable to continue utilizing the ICPA the COM would have to source a quote directly from ADP which would result in higher pricing including an overall higher annual investment and setup costs. The pricing negotiated by ICPA/Omnia is more advantageous to the Comptroller's Office.
