The Bidder/Offeror shall limit access to the Confidential Information to employees and agents having a demonstrable need to know such Confidential Information and who are bound by confidentiality obligations at least as restrictive as those set forth in this Agreement. In the event the State suffers any losses, damages, liabilities, expenses, or costs (including, by way of example only, attorneys' fees and disbursements) that are attributable, in whole or in part to any failure by the Bidder/Offeror or any employee or agent of the Bidder/Offeror to comply with the requirements of this Agreement, Bidder/Offeror and such employees and agents of Bidder/Offeror shall hold harmless and indemnify the State from and against any such losses, damages, liabilities, expenses, and/or costs.
- 5. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Maryland.
